Message to Parents and Students

Few high school students see the connection between high school courses and their future career choices. Another difficulty is connecting high school courses with the skills necessary to get a job. Identifying a career path helps students make these connections. The process involves identifying career interests, aligning them with a career path, and developing a four-year plan. The process prepares the student to identify goals, choose postsecondary options, and transition to the workplace. The benefits of participating in a Career Pathway Program include the experience of choosing classes to meet a goal that is similar to completing a major in college, an award to list on a college application, and a topic for the college essay. The steps to apply are:

- Students will be called to schedule an appointment with a Career Pathway Advisor

Graduate with a Career Pathway Cord in your chosen area of expertise . . .

By completing six (6) semester courses within a selected career pathway, you may be eligible to wear a special colored cord at graduation.

THE BENEFITS:

- *The experience of choosing classes to meet a goal that is similar to completing a major in college
- *An award to list on a college application
- *A topic for a college essay

Career Pathway Cords at Graduation:

- Arts and Communication - Orange Cord
- Business & Marketing - Red Cord
- Consumer & Human Services - Purple Cord
- Health Sciences - Green Cord
- Science & Technology - Blue Cord

The student must receive a B or higher in all Career Pathway Program coursework, maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA, and demonstrate satisfactory citizenship/effort. Thirty (30) hours of community service and eight (8) hours of job shadowing, in a minimum of 2 - 4 places, must be completed at business/community sites within the selected Career Pathway. The student must submit a PCHS transcript, professional resume, sample job application, and a skills assessment to a Career Pathway advisor for final approval six weeks prior to graduation. At that time, the student will schedule the required PowerPoint presentation highlighting the community service experience. The good news - students complete the professional resume, the sample job application, the skills assessment, community service hours, and the PowerPoint presentation within English courses and Senior Project taken at Pacific Coast High School.

You may obtain an application and course option information for each Career Pathway Program from Nancy McKeegan. This opportunity to set a goal and follow through is excellent practice for selecting a college major and making a career connection in the near future.

Good planning is essential. It is ideal to choose your Pathway and commit to the Career Pathway Program during your freshman or sophomore year.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is a Career Pathway Cord?

Colored cord which represents a career focus to be worn at graduation that recognizes your performance during your high school experience.

Who May Earn a Career Pathway Cord?

Any student who completes the requirements and, of course, the process is optional.

Why Earn a Career Pathway Cord?

- Direction for post-secondary planning
- Award that may be listed on a college application
- Item that may be listed on a resume for college and/or workplace
- Topic for college essay

Can I earn a cord and go to college?

Definitely! However, it will take careful planning when choosing electives.

Can I earn more than one cord?

It would be very difficult to complete all the requirements for more than one cord during your four years at PCHS.

What are the benefits of earning a cord?

- Choosing classes to meet a goal which is similar to completing a major in college
- Identifying personal interests and skills
- Learning about careers and workplace expectations

When do I start?

The sooner, the better! It is strongly recommended that you decide by Fall semester of your sophomore year.
