IMPORTANT GRADING INFORMATION:

If you reach the end of the trimester and you have not mastered the lessons you were assigned, you will receive a grade of "NC" (No Credit) for the class. You will have the following trimester* to finish the course and earn a grade and 5 credits. It is the student's responsibility to add this Rosetta Stone course to your course schedule with an Add/Drop slip.

If, at the end of your second trimester*, you have still not completed your course, you will receive a grade of "NC" and you will not be allowed to enroll in another Rosetta Stone course.

* PCHS offers a 1st trimester (July/ August) . You may begin a Rosetta Stone course or continue a course from the spring trimester. If the course is not completed during the 1st trimester you will earn a grade of "NC", however this trimester will not count as one of the two trimesters in which you are allowed to earn a grade of "NC".
