Minimal acceptance considerations for PCHS:

- Student must indicate they want to participate in our program. No student can be made to enroll.
- Student must have a minimum junior high curriculum performance level.
- Student earned credits must be within goals of their class year (approx. 50-60 credits per school year earned) This is a guideline, as often credits can be made up.
- Student must have life skills that can help them manage a weekly syllabus, and/or have support at home from someone who can help them.
- Student and parents understand there is a weekly due date for assignments and communication with school personnel is required.

PCHS will look at the whole student and review the indicators for success, as well as the challenges a student may have, when considering acceptance.

Grade Disputes; Any student or parent with concerns about course grades are welcome to address their concerns with the course instructor for up to one semester after the course has ended.
