STUDENT ACTIVITIES GUEST BEHAVIORAL COMMITMENT

All students attending a Pacific Coast High School activity, on or off campus, are expected to know appropriate behavior is required and that all school rules are enforced at any activity sponsored by Pacific Coast High School. All students and parents should be aware of the following *Code of Student Expectations*.

<u>Drugs, Alcohol, Controlled Substances, Drug Paraphernalia</u>: The use, possession, or sale of alcohol, drugs, narcotics, including "look-a-likes", drug paraphernalia, and other illegal substances is prohibited on school property or at any school-sponsored event/activity, regardless of the event site.

<u>Fighting</u>: Fighting will not be permitted on campus or at any school event. Generally fault can be found with all participants.

<u>Possession of Dangerous Objects:</u> A student shall not possess, sell, or otherwise furnish any firearm (real or simulated), knife, explosive device, or other dangerous object on campus or at any school event. Mace or other defensive protectants are also not allowed on campus or at any school event.

<u>Smoking Regulations/Tobacco</u>: The use or possession of tobacco in any form is not permitted on or within 200 yards of school property or at school events.

<u>Theft, Graffiti, Damage to and/or Destruction of Personal or School Property:</u> A student should not cause, or attempt to cause, damage to school or private property including buildings, grounds, windows, etc.

<u>Threats to Cause Physical Harm:</u> A student shall not cause, threaten, or attempt to cause, physical injury to another student or staff member on campus or at any school event.

All guests must arrive with a PCHS student to Prom.

<u>Prom Dress Code</u>: Jacket and tie or tuxedo for the boys and appropriate formal attire for all girls. Attendees with inappropriate attire, i.e.: girls: too short, too revealing; boys: informal attire, lack of jacket and tie, will not be allowed to enter the dance. Changing outfits is not allowed at the dance once attendees have entered.
